HOW TO TRAVEL TO GREENWICH

By **tube**: *North Greenwich Station* (Jubilee Line) and then any bus towards Greenwich Town Centre

DLR: *Greenwich Station / Cutty Sark*

By **train** (Southeastern Rail): *Greenwich Station*

Riverboat Services from Westminster, Embankment, London Bridge City, Canary Wharf and Tower Piers to Greenwich.

By **plane**: *London City Airport* (20 min), *Gatwick Airport* (53 min), *Luton Airport* (80 min), *Heathrow Airport* (70 min).

Greenwich is just 8 minutes from London Bridge!




ACTIVITIES



